The Botswana National Olympic Committee (BNOC) strives to promote excellence in Elite Sport through simultaneous support of athletes, administrators and coaches, and other sport support services. These programmes have been supported mainly through Botswana Government and Olympic Solidarity funding.

Botswana National Olympic Committee is a statutory sporting authority in Botswana under the International Olympic Committee and also serves as body in charge of Commonwealth Games for Botswana; which is committed to achieving the highest excellence in sport. It strives to provide a safe and healthy working environment for all employees, tolerant of cultural diversity, the right to different opinions and fair treatment of all employees. Overall Job Purpose

To set a clear strategic direction for the promotion and development of elite sport in Botswana, oversee the preparation and delivery of Team Botswana at all multi-sport international games including the Olympics, Commonwealth Games, Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF) Youth Games and African Games and build internal capability to deliver on the mandate of the BNOC.

Key Performance Areas

- Provides the requisite leadership and strategic direction of the BNOC in line with the set mandate of the organisation.
- Institutes necessary budgetary processes to ensure effective resource mobilisation, allocation and monitoring.
- Identifies and pursues other potential revenue streams to meet operational costs.
- Collaborates and maintains effective strategic relationships with key stakeholders.
- Develops a wide range of relationships and networks locally, regionally and internationally
- Acts as a liaison between the BNOC and other sports agencies on elite sport development matters and ensures compliance with national and appropriate international regulations.
- Institutes a culture of high performance that is supportive of elite sport development and the mandate of the BNOC;
- Acts as Chief Spokesperson of the BNOC; and
- Undertake other such duties as directed by the Board of Directors.
